

## El Camagüey and Some Camagüeyans in Cuba's Independence Wars

One of the greatest and most impacting events which our Cuban ancestors lived through, and by the tens of thousands died in, was our island's struggle for independence. The Spanish colonial rule existed and thrived for well over three centuries in Cuba. But ruling a population of Peninsular Spaniards, long-established Creoles, mulattoes and large numbers of African slaves was a complicated undertaking, and more so to be done from halfway across the world. These long centuries had a tremendous effect on the educated Creoles of Cuba who were well aware of the ideas of Enlightenment, of the American and French Revolutions, and even more so of continuing to be the recipient of abusive Spanish administrative policies that were draining the national resources away from the country. Tensions finally peaked in the form of a revolution against Spanish rule in 1868. In an attempt to increase our knowledge of our Cuban ancestors and their involvement in the struggle for independence, especially those from the province of Camaguey, this account is given with open arms to all so interested in the history of the Cuban people and in that of their island: "The Pearl of the Antilles".

While Oriente had a strong movement that was on the brink of declaring war, among the earliest proposals in Camaguey, for the purpose of organizing a second front of rebellion against Spanish forces in Cuba, occurred during July of 1868. An influential resident, patriot and member of the Masonic Order of Tínima of Camaguey, Francisco María Rubalcaba, proposed to his fellow Masons that revolutionary activities be conducted in the province as a sign of solidarity with Oriente. However, because of Masonic laws prohibiting talk of politics in the meeting hall, a group of 40 Masons met on the sugar mill and plantation of "Jiquí", owned by Eduardo Agramonte. There, only two leagues from the then colonial city of Puerto Príncipe — later renamed Ciudad del Camagüey— under the patriotic and mature leadership of Ignacio Agramonte, the Camagüeyans agreed to the cry of "Indepen-

dence or Death!\*. From the forty conspirators two were chosen to meet with the delegation from Oriente during the coming months. The men elected were Salvador Cisneros Betancourt and Carlos de Varona y de la Torre.

On the 3rd of August of 1868 the representatives from Camagüey held secret reunions with their counterparts in the province of Oriente. They assembled on the farm and country estate by the name of "San Miguel del Rompe" located near Las Tunas, Oriente. discussions were conducted on the 1st of September on another rural real estate called "Muñoz", also in the vicinity of Las Tunas. The main purpose achieved during these contacts was the ratification of Camaguey's seconding the early rebellion begun by Oriente. Attempts were made to coordinate large-scale military action with the termination of the extremely valuable sugar harvest for the year of 1868-1869. These decisions, however, were not adhered to. An already hasty choice for the commencing of direct combat with Spanish forces, set for December 24 of 1868, had to be shortened by more than two months. The reason for such hasty action was founded on the facts that Spanish intelligence had obtained important information and details on the rebels' uprising.

The last few hours of the 9th of October suddenly became the dark but enlightened early morning of October 10, 1868. On this eternal day, on the sugar plantation and mill of "La Demajagua", whose owner was Carlos Manuel de Céspedes y López del Castillo, a solid core of Cuban patriots and lovers of their province of Oriente, gave out a cry of independence. This declaration of insurrection against Spain was the first of such a tremendous magnitude that it can truly be classified as Cuba's first revolution. The original date for this patriotic cry, however, was to have been the 14th of October, but because of a Spanish order for the arrest of Céspedes and other revolutionary leaders, the revolt was hastened. Though October 10 has by all means its place secured in Cuban history one should not forget and definitely come to know a major decision-making event which had occurred only four days earlier.

October 6th was the day the event took place at the sugar mill and

plantation by the name of "Rosario", which was the property of Jaime M. Santiesteban. Located only three leagues outside the town of Manzanillo, Oriente, this was the place selected by 16 masons from the Masonic Order of Buena Fe of Manzanillo. Under the leadership of their head Mason, Carlos Manuel de Céspedes, these men all agreed with great and energetic patriotism to give their "Grito de Independencia" and named Céspedes "Jefe de la Independencia". At this point the 14th was chosen as the official date to declare Cuban independence from Spain, but as mentioned the revolutionaries had to make a hasty declaration on the 10th of October of 1868, due to the incoming Spanish forces. Thus, to give these early accords a legal and judicial nature the 16 men wrote up "El Acta de Independencia de Cuba" and all signed it as follows:

By the midnight hours of October 11, 1868, the Cuban citizenry of Puerto Principe had learned of the declaration in Oriente to their extreme surprise. Not only had the original date set for the 14th seemed hasty to the rebellion in Camagüey, but in fact, any type of direct confrontation on a revolutionary scale before late December was taken as self-destructive and anarchic. Such must have been the tension experienced all throughout the province as all attention was focused on the successes or failures of the Oriente rebellion. Finally the spirited news needed to increase confidence in the province arrived in the form of the taking of Bayamo on the 20th of October. Spanish forces in Puerto Principe were agitated by such a loss, though truly symbolic by any account, and the leaders of the Camagüeyan front immediately began planning for their own call-to arms.

In the Liceo (a Cuban literary-cultural society) of Puerto Príncipe

there was a meeting held on November 1st of the same year by all the major patriots of the area and in which support was declared for Céspedes. A continuation of this meeting was conducted at night in the home of Dolores Boza, widow of Miranda, at the end of which the decision was made to declare the province of Camagüey up in arms. On the 3rd another gathering was held at the Liceo for two purposes. First, the decision made at the home of Dolores Boza was reported to all the members of the rebellion and then a day and locality were selected for the uprising. The day was the 4th of November of that very impacting year of 1868. The site, three leagues to the north of Puerto Príncipe, was the stream-river (depending on the season) of Las Clavellinas. All was set for Camagüey's whole-hearted involvement in Cuba's struggle for independence and in order to achieve a degree of simultaneousness, dispatches were delivered to Nuevitas, Guáimaro, Sibanicú, and Cascorro.

One of the men who attended this call-to-arms was Colonel Francisco de Arredondo y Miranda. By doing so, he became an important figure among that group of early and patriotic combatants for Camagüey, and thus, for all of Cuba. While in Caracas, Venezuela, he published his account of the Ten Years' War titled "Recuerdos de la Guerra de Cuba". This account was published on March 22, 1894 and has tremendous value in the history of the province of Camagüey. Thus, because if its value, a brief passage dealing with the call-to-arms on the margins of the stream-river Las Clavellinas has been translated and follows as such:

"On the morning of the 4th of November of 1868, Wednesday, at 7 o'clock, I left from the Camagüeyan city (Puerto Príncipe) accompanied by the patriots Cirilo and José Morel y Jiqués, Carlos Guerra y Agüero, Esteban Estrada y Varona and Rafael Benavides y Márques, directing ourselves to the crossing of the river of Las Clavenillas, place that had been designated since the 3rd for the gathering of those of us that were rising ourselves up in arms against the government of Spain in Cuba, seconding the revolution initiated in the plantation "La Demajagua" the 10th of October by the great Bayamés and immortal "caudillo" (leader).

"Gathered on the margin of the river of Las Clavenillas, on the road from Nuevitas and distancing three leagues from the city (Puerto Príncipe), we, 76 Camagüeyans, having fulfilled our pledged word of rising ourselves up that day, embarked on a march at 10 o'clock in the morning to the plantation "El Cercado", of Martín Castillo y Agramonte (property actually belonged to Tomás Pio Betancourt; Castillo's father—in-law) arriving at it, around 11:30 o'clock, marching as explorers were the patriots, doctor Francisco Argilagos y Ginferrer, Rafael de Varona y Varona and Eduardo Montejo y Varona."

"Installed in the house-plantation the 76 concurrent patriots, by indication of doctor Eduardo Agramonte y Piña, proceeded to organize themselves militarily..."

These patriots indeed organized themselves into a small but effective force of dedicated Camagüeyans, spirited by the drive of independence, and ready to achieve their goals or die fighting. Once they had formally evolved into a force capable of combating Spain's powerful army they went on to declare their allegiance to "the Holy Cause of the Independence of Cuba" and gave energetic cries of Long Live: "Cuba Libre, Carlos Manuel de Céspedes, Camagüey and Jeronimo Boza!". Without doubt this was Camagüey's premier army on independence and has a great role in the history of the province and in that of Cuba's history. Thus, the following is an outline of the historic group of leaders:

Now transformed into an organized and capable fighting force, these men prepared themselves to lead their province's uprising against Spanish rule wherever they encountered it. Their very first military action took place that same day. On the 4th of November of 1868 Camaguey's rebel-in arms were able to force the surrender of a Spanish garrison composed of a lieutenat and 30 cavalrymen. This action, under the leadership of Augusto and Napoleón Arango, was their very first military undertaking. In order to create a provincial leadership to direct Camaguey's rebellion the "Revolutionary Committee of Camaguey" was established, and was directed by Salvador Cisneros Betancourt, Ignacio Agramonte Loynaz and Eduardo Agramonte Piña. For a brief period it served as the revolution's governement in the province and conducted all military activities under the direction of Agusto Arango. The Committee was founded on the 26th and only two days later, on the 28th, there occurred the first major battle faced by this force. It was the battle of "Bonilla" and the patriots were up against the Spanish military under the command of the Count of Valmaseda. A force of 2500 men with modern armaments and an impressive display of artillery pieces, prepared to easily destroy anything in its path, met up with 150 poorly armed Cubans. The will of those revolutionaries, however, was so strong that they were actually able to cause Valmaseda's troops to retreat for the day. Such was the energy of those early days of combat in Camagüey.

The fact that the "Revolutionary Committee of Camagüey" lacked a democratic foundation caused it to disintegrate within a few months and thus gave way to election. Voted into power by their fellow Camagüeyans-in-arms were Salvador Cisneros Betancourt, Ignacio Agramonte, Eduardo Agramonte, Antonio Zambrana and Francisco Sánchez. These men now assembled together and gave birth to the "Assembly of Representatives of el Centro" (Camagüey), which by the 26th of February of 1869 was well established. On that day the assembly voted to abolish slavery on all the territories under its jurisdiction.

We have now arrived at a major date in the forming of the Cuban nation. It was April 10, 1869 and for the first time the representatives from Oriente, Camagüey and Las Villas came together at what would be named the "Assembly of Guáimaro". They met in the town of Guáimaro, Oriente in order to plant the seeds from which, they hoped, would grow a democratic republic based on the liberal principles of the French Revolution. The following men, all having a tremendous sense of patriotism and responsibility, gathered to accomplish a basic goal; Unity.

Among the most important accords reached at this assembly was the united declaration by the three provinces of the "Republic of Cuba in Arms", to ratify provincial declarations of independence from the Spanish colonial government, and to officially abolish slavery in all lands under rebel authority. Then began the work on a national constitution which would be titled the "Fundamental Document of the Republic of Cuba" and having the basic contents of a democratic constitution. The government of the revolution would have a judicial. legislative and an executive branch, along with a "Chamber of Representatives". As was the case in Bayamo, the rebels in order to prevent Spanish troops from invading the town, went on to burn the entire structure before leaving in the face of the incoming Count of Valmaseda. Before such action was taken, however, major decisions were made as to the organization of the rebellion's armed forces. For the first time all three provinces joined together as an organized army and, by the 31st of April of 1869, had acquired the following leadership structure and organization.

Such was the formation of the revolutionary army of Cuba which would struggle for ten years against Spanish colonial rule. The

ultimate outcome was the devastation of the island during a decade of military deadlock for both sides and thus, in 1878, Spanish and rebel forces agreed on a conditional cease-fire at the "Pact of Zanión". Finally, with the exception of a brief period of hostilities by the rebel faction of Antonio Maceo in 1879, the entire island can begin to live a normal life and recover from such a bloody and extensively destructive campaign. A brief series of the major events of the years following the "Assembly of Guáimaro" will give one a general knowledge of Cuba, and especially Camagüey, during these turbulent years. Additionally, a very short presentation of some important points covering the period of 1895-1898 will also follow. in order to gain a general sense of the quick and shocking speed of the Cuban "War of Independence", of those In conclusion, a brief and obviously very incomplete same years. compilation is presented for those of our ancestors who fought, died. saw defeat and/or triumph within the jurisdiction of Ciego de Avila, Camaguey. Reiterating the basic goal of increasing our knowledge of our Cuban, and especially Camagueyan, ancestors who were involved in the island's wars of independence, it is humbly hoped that the reader has gained a further and more profound relation to those periods of sacrifice and suffering for Cuban auto-determination.

# Family of Vicente de Escobar y Flores Painter of the Royal Chambers.

#### I The Escobar

Antonio de Escobar was Captain of the Batallon de Pardos in Havana, according to the testament of his son, Antonio Feliciano. There are very few facts to be found in his marriage entry, where it only mentions that he married at the Parroquia Mayor, March 27 1740, with Maria de Jesus Recio, a free mulatto, born in Havana, and daughter of Lieutenant Carlos Recio and Luisa de Soto.

Antonio de Escobar and María de Jesús Recio had, among other children, a son, Antonio Feliciano de Escobar y Recio, free mulatto, born in Havana, as it is mentioned in his marriage and death entries. Antonio Feliciano, while being an Ensign, and his father a Captain, was married on 26 January 1759 with Justa María de Flores, also a free mulatto, and daughter of Captain Antonio de Flores and Isabel Vázquez.

On 18 April 1792 Antonio Feliciano, being gravely ill, wrote his testament before the notary public, José Gabriel de Quiñonez. In the testament he declared that he wants his body to be dressed in the habit of the Franciscan monks, or if there is any difficulty, to use the habit of the Augustine monks, and that he wants to be buried by the Parish of Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. He declared that he did not

bring to his marriage any endowment, but that his wife brought four hundred pesos that she inherited from her parents, and one hundred pesos more in jewelry. He declared that the house in which he lives belongs to Barbara Rodríguez de Ortega, to whom he pays twelve pesos on rent annually. He also declared that he owned, together with his brother-in-law Ignacio Antonio de Flores y Vázquez, two slave carabali women named María de la Luz and Mariana. He also owned a slave congo girl named Francisca, and a congo boy named Domingo. He declared that Captain Manuel Chacon owed him four hundred pesos that he had loaned him in cash. He declared not to owe anything to anyone. He declared that during his marriage with Justa María they had many children, of which the following were still alive: María Micaela, Vicente, María Luisa, José María, José Anselmo, Antonio José and María Rafaela. The first three were older that twenty five years of age, and the others were older that fourteen years of age. He declared that his son José Antonio helped him earn the property he possessed and as a reward he leaves him a fifth of the fortune that is left, after his business are put in order. He named as trustee of his fortune his wife Justa María de Flores and his brotherin-law Ignacio Antonio de Flores and his son Vicente, who is also named tutor and guardian of his younger brothers and sisters who are less than twenty five years of age. He named as his only heirs his legitimate children María Micaela, Vicente, María Luisa, José María, José Anselmo, Antonio José and María Rafaela de Escobar y Flores.

At the auxiliary Church of Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe and San Francisco Javier, outside the city walls of Havana, Antonio Feliciano de Escobar was buried on May 4, 1792, dressed on the habit of the order of Nuestra Señora de las Mercedes. Acta No. 930, Folio No. 127. Tomo 3, Entierros de Pardos, Morenos e Indios.

In the testament that Justa María de Flores wrote before her death, among other things, she mentions that her legitimate children are Micaela, who is about fifty years old; Vicente, who is about forty eight years old; Luisa who is about forty seven years old; Anselmo who is about forty years old; José María, who died older that twenty five some ten years ago; Antonio, who is about thirty two years old and Rafaela who is about twenty eight years old. Justa María was buried on 19

December 1819, at the general cemetery. Acta 808, Folio 102 Tomo 9 Entierros de Pardos y Morenos, Auxiliary Church of Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe.

The children of Antonio de Escobar and Justa María de Flores will be treated as follows:

- 1. Micaela de Escobar y Flores was baptized at the Parroquia Mayor in Havana on 9 October 1760. She was married to Juan González, and had no children. In her testament she declared to have brought up Isabel, Nicolas and Santiago Francisco Valdés, orphan children from the Real Casa Cuna. Micaela died on 10 October 1815. Her testament is kept at the National Archives, under the notary public Felipe Alvarez, Expediente 11, Legajo 400.
- 2. Luisa de Escobar y Flores was married on 30 August 1789 with José Anacleto Buenaventura Infanzón, a free mulatto, born in Havana, legitimate son of Diego Francisco Suárez Infanzón and Inés Gertrudis Bonora. Acta 234, Folio 143, Tomo 2, Matrimonios de Pardos y Morenos. She wrote her testament while still in good health on 6 March 1821. In it she declared that her husband had died two years after their marriage, and they had no children. She left as her heirs Inés, Cayetana, Marcelina and Dolores Valdés, orphan children from the Real Casa Cuna.
- 3. José Anselmo de Escobar y Flores, married on 19 January 1795 at the church of Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe y San Francisco Javier with María Guadalupe Veloso, a free mulatto, born in Havana legitimate daughter of Francisco Veloso and Josefa Teresa de León. Acta 90, Folio 23, Tomo 3, Matrimonios de Pardos y Morenos. In the directory of the city of 1840, appears a listing for Anselmo Escobar, carpenter, with a establishment at San Rafael No. 27. We only have knowledge of one legitimate daughter named María del Pilar mentioned by Rafaela de Escobar in her will.
- 4. Antonio de Escobar y Flores was born around 1778 and had at least one legitimate son, Gabriel, mentioned by Rafaela de Escobar in her will. We do not have any more information on Antonio. A José María

de Escobar, residing on Lealtad No. 68, who was a painter, was listed in the directory of the city of 1840. Perhaps he was the son of Antonio, or maybe José Anselmo, since their brother José María had died in 1800.

- 5. Rafaela de Escobar y Flores used to sign her name as Escobal. She wrote her testament on 22 March 1831, before Cristobal de Tagle. She declared that she was married to Juan de la Cruz Oriarola and that all her children had died in infancy. She again wrote another testament on 24 July 1842. She declared as her heirs José Anselmo, her brother; Isabel and Nicolas Valdés, children brought up by her sister Micaela; she left one hundred pesos each to Ines, Cayetana Marcelina and Dolores Valdés, children brought up by her sister Luisa. She left her furniture to be divided between José Anselmo and José Escobar, a moreno servant of José Anselmo. She left fifty pesos to Margarita Valdés, one hundred to her niece María del Pilar, legitimate daughter of José Anselmo and fifty pesos to Gabriel, her nephew, son of Antonio Escobar.
- 6. Vicente de Escobar y Flores was Painter of the Royal Chambers of his Majesty the King Don Fernando VII. Vicente was baptized at the Parish of San Cristobal in Havana. Acta 446, Folio 117, Tomo 16, Bautisos de Pardos y Morenos. His legitimate wife was Josefa de Estrada y Pimienta. In their mutual testament, dated July 30, 1833, they declared to have been married for 35 years. Josefa Estrada was very young when she married Vicente since her baptism was on January 13, 1783. She was the legitimate daughter of Manuel Ignacio de Estrada and María de Jesús Pimienta, both of Havana. In the National Archives there is a document that records the calling of Vicente Escobar to be the Painter of the Royal Chambers.

The testament before mentioned, dated July 30 1833, declares that Vicente and Josefa, after being married for thirty five years did not have any children. She declared to be the daughter of Manuel Duque de Estrada and María de Jesús Pimienta, all from Havana. They left one hundred pesos to Jose Anselmo. They left their slaves Nicolas and María de Jesús priced at four hundred pesos each. They declared that all their property had been obtained after they were married, and that

neither one of them brought anything to the marriage. They declared that they owed money to Francisco Javier de Arriola and that the exact amount was to be figured out and written in later. They declared that they had in their possession the amount of four hundred pesos that belonged to Santiago Valdes, and that it was to be turned over to him, after paying any debts that he might incur. They named each others as trustees and Francisco Arriola trustee after them. They declared each other as their only heirs to honor the love, fidelity and constancy that they shared while married. Vicente de Escobar y Flores was buried on April 8, 1834 at the General Cemetery. Acta 219, Folio 32, Tomo 18, Defunciones de Blancos. Parish of Espiritu Santo.

Josefa Estrada y Pimienta married Francisco Javier Rodríguez on October 22, 1835. He was the son of Jose Nicolas Rodríguez and Teresa Gabriela Viamontes. Acta 251, Tomo 10, Matrimonios de Blancos, Parish of Espiritu Santo. He was born on March 26 1790, and baptized at the Parroquia Mayor of Havana. His first wife, Maria de los Dolores Valdés was an orphan from the Real Casa Cuna, and died on October 5, 1832. Acta 2, Folio 149, Tomo 19, Defunciones de Blancos, Parish of Espiritu Santo.

On April 15, 1837 Josefa Estrada y Pimienta wrote a testament, where she declared to have been born in San Felipe y Santiago de Bejucal, Havana. Daughter of Manuel Ignacio Duque de Estrada and María Eulalia Pimienta. She declared to be ill, and that she wanted to be buried at the General Cemetery. She declared to have contributed to her second marriage the amount of eleven thousand pesos. She declared not to have had any children. She declared to give liberty to her slave, named Maria de Jesus, a carabali, and to price her slaves Nicolas at two hundred pesos.

On May 5, 1837 Josefa de Estrada was buried at the General Cemetery. Acta 885, Folio 144, Tomo 18, Entierros de Blancos, Parish of Espiritu Santo.

#### II The Flores

Magdalena de Flores, widow of Bartolomé García, a free mulatto, wrote a testament before the notary public Manuel de Redín on August 8, 1731. She was ill and declared that she wanted her body to be dressed with the habit of the Augustine monks. She had no children in her marriage to Bartolomé García. She brought no endowment to their marriage and he brought the farm-yard named San Francisco de Paula, plus goods amounting to two thousand pesos. He also brought two slaves, one of which was sold, and the other died. He left Magdalena as his only heir, with the exception of some things he left to his niece.

Magdalena was a woman of business that took care of many trades after her husband died. She had 4 slaves and lived with her nephew Teodoro de Casas.

According to the testament's lengthy details of all the going on, Magdalena had a four sons named Juan, José, Tomás and Antonio de Flores. She also had three daughters named Juana de la Rosa, Angela and María de Flores. They were named heirs together with her grandchildren from her deceased daughter Juana de la Rosa and Tomás de Escobar, Cayetano, Juan and Estevan.

Magdalena was buried on August 18 1732 at the Convent of San Augustine. Acta 192, Folio ?, Tomo 8, Entierros de Pardos y Morenos, Parroquia Mayor.

Antonio de Flores, son of Magdalena de Flores, a free mulatto was a carpenter. He married Isabel Vázquez, on October 22, 1732. Acta 22, Folio ?, Tomo 2 Matrimonios de Pardos y Morenos. Isabel Vázquez was baptized on September 8, 1706, the daughter of Alvaro Vázquez and Bibiana Tinoco, free mulatto, from Hayana.

He died on July 26, 1762 while the English were taking Havana. He was a Commandant of the Batallon de Milicia de Pardos de la Plaza de la Habana. He was buried at the Parroquia Mayor, in Havana. Acta 362, Folio 58, Tomo 5, Entierros de Indios, Pardos y Morenos.

On July 9, 1762, being ill, he wrote a testament before the notary public Juan de Salinas. He left as trustee his brother-in-law Francisco Vázquez y Tinoco and his wife Isabel Vázquez y Tinoco together with Manuel Báez. His heirs were his three legitimate children, Jose Ignacio, Ignacio Antonio and Justa María del Flores y Vázquez. He declared that he give freedom to his slave girls, Catalina de Flores and Sebastiana María de Flores.

To get some information about Antonio De Flores, we need to read the testament of his mother-in-law Bibiana Tinoco, who was the recipient of Antonio's generous nature and who credits him with having help her family in time of need, with his carpenter's skills. It also mentions that he took care of three children, Mariana, Manuela and Antonio del Rosario, whose parent were not able to.

Antonio had a natural daughter, named María del Rosario, who lived with his brother Juan de Orta. Antonio tried to have the child live with him and his family, but his brother would not agree to it. When the matter went to court, the child was old enough to decide where she wanted to live, and she opted for staying with her uncle. Antonio did not forget to have her as an heir in his wills, which he often updated. He also kept in mind the children he was protecting, Mariana, Manuela and Antonio del Rosario, whose last name was Interian. He left his carpenter's shop to Antonio del Rosario Interian as he promised him.

The first testament that Antonio de Flores wrote was on September 2, 1739, when he was very ill. Then, when he was healthy, on February 23, 1740, he changed the testament. On May 29, 1742 he made some changes again. Since he was a military man, he must have left the urgency of having his affairs in order.

His daughter Justa María de Flores married Antonio de Escobar and was the mother of Vicente de Escobar y Flores, Painter of the Royal Chambers of his Majesty the King Fernando VII.

# PARISH REGISTER OF SAN JUAN DE LOS REMEDIOS, LAS VILLAS, CUBA

The transcriptions of the books in the parish of San Juan de los Remedios were done by Jose Antonio Mahy, an associate of Francisco Xavier de Santa Cruz, and very well known for his own accomplishments.

This transcriptions start with book number One, and continue with Two and Three. The listing has all the entries found in these books. The first book, comprising the years 1648 to 1770, was in very bad conditions and there are a lot of facts that could not be read. This book has a good number of marriages of slaves and free blacks residents of Remedios. All the entries in this book are included in this listing.

Book number Two is partly included here, and will be continued in the next issue. This book comprises the years 1701 to 1751. Its condition was better and not so many facts are missing. There are no marriages of blacks in this book. They may have been kept in another book.

The information contained in the following listing has the same format as previously used. To recap: The surname and given name are found first, followed by the sex of the individual, the date of the marriage, a letter indicating whether the individual listed is the one being married (M), or is associated genealogically (G); this G follows the names of parents or other spouses and witnesses. The numbers at the very end refer to the page and entry number of the original transcription. These are helpful in looking at the individuals identified in a given entry and may also be used for further reference in corresponding with CGS to get a printout of the entry or in using the manuscript found at the Hialeah Family History Library.
